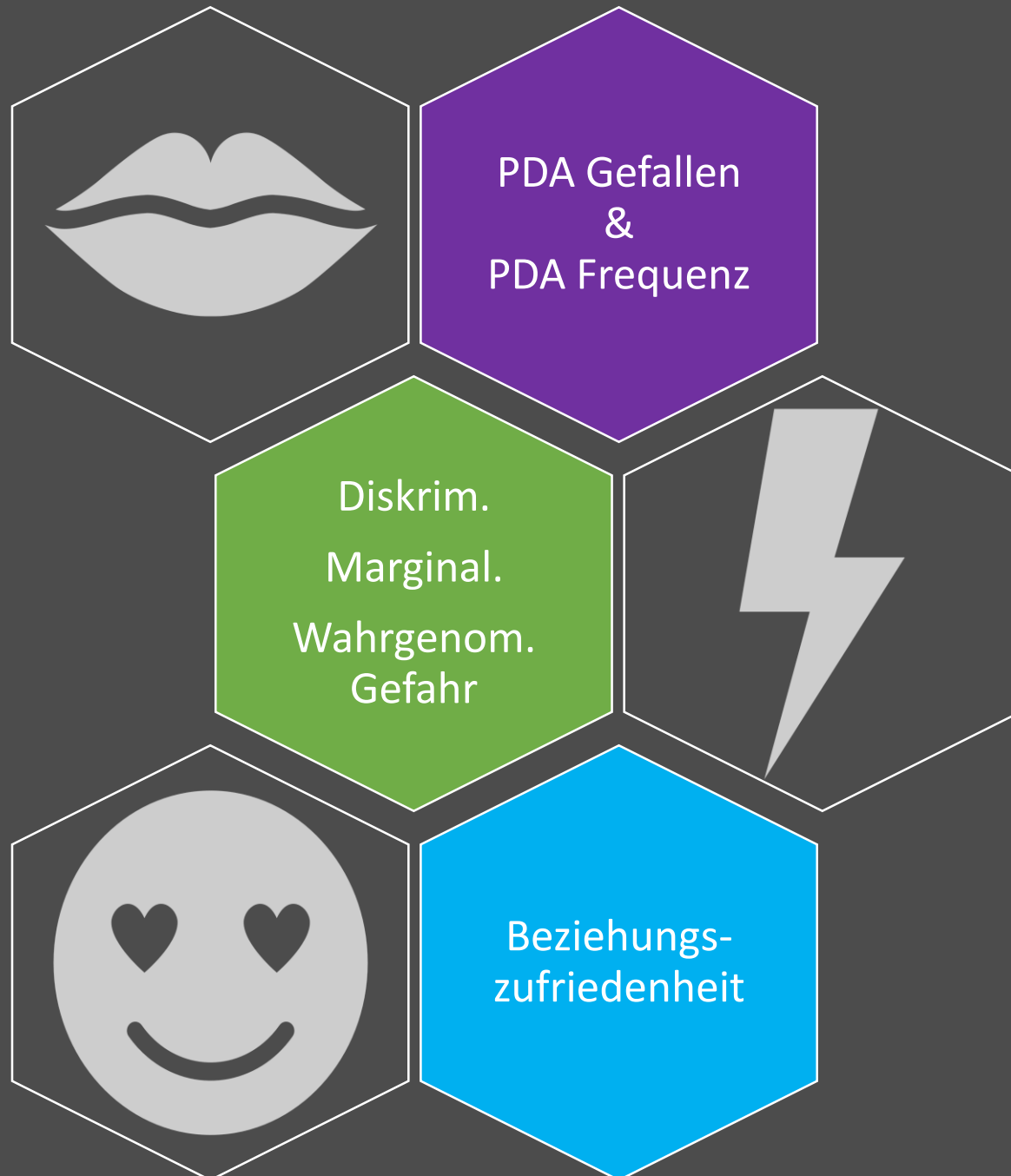

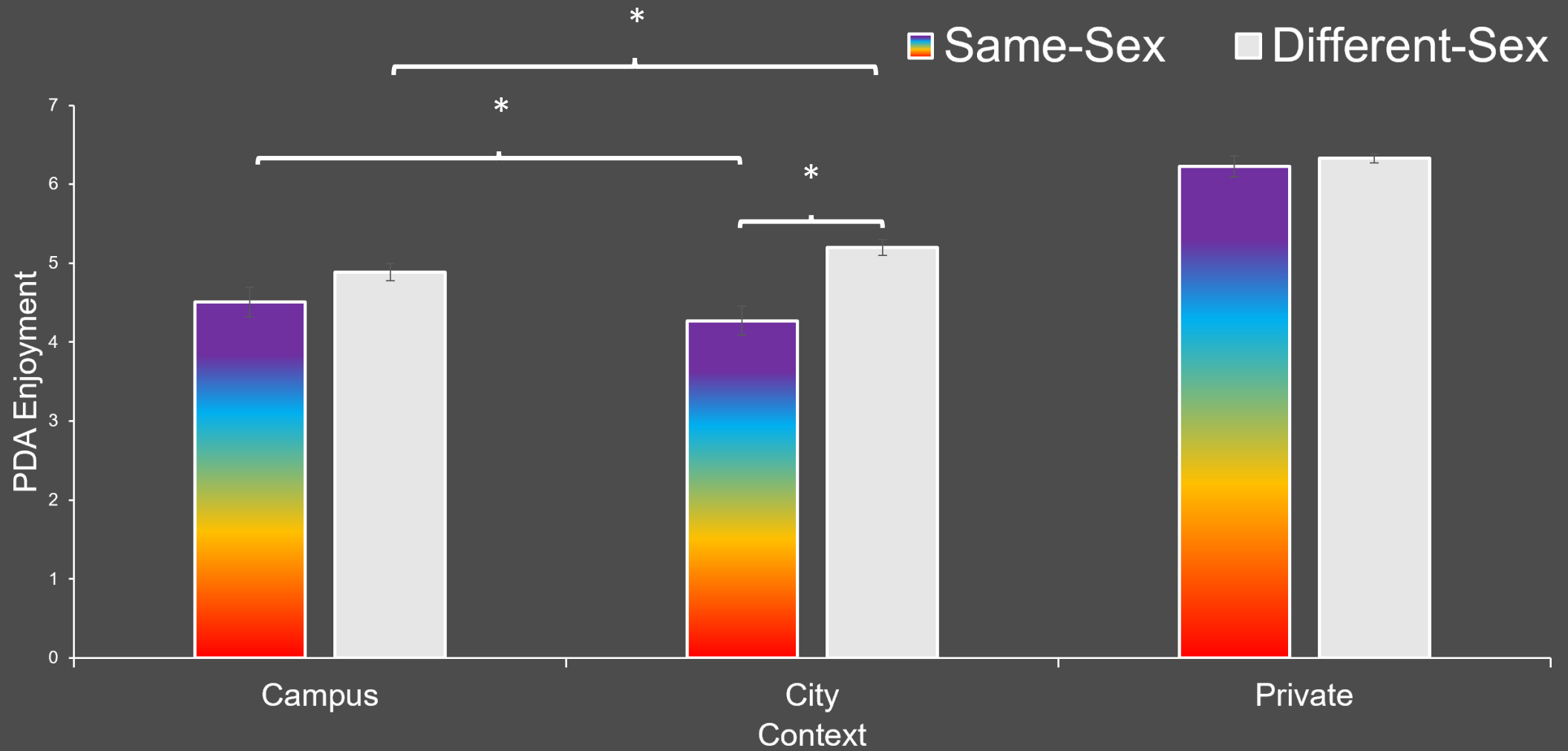

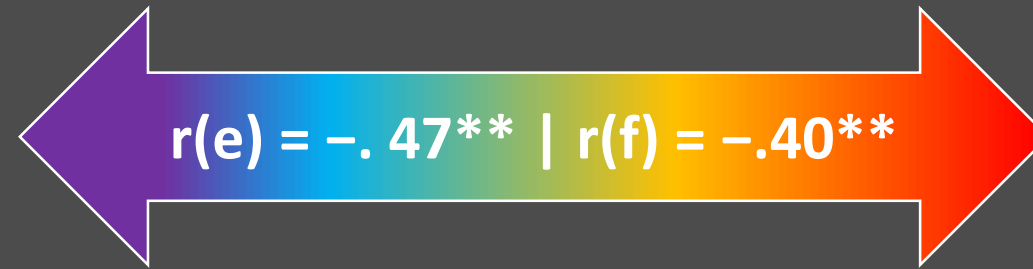


Ergebnisse – PDA Frequenz

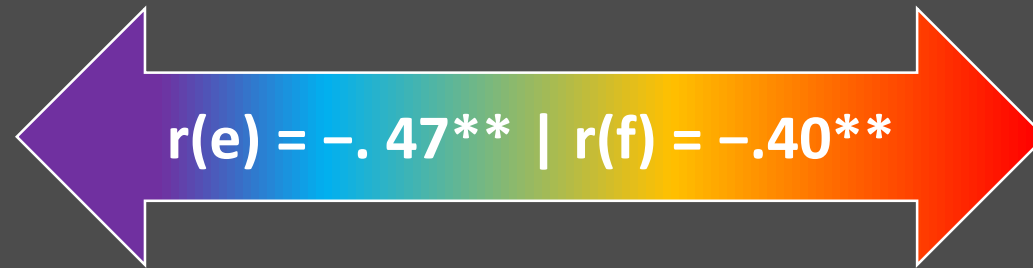

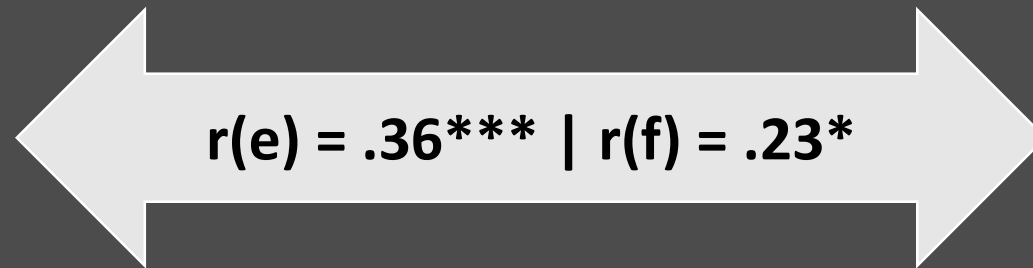
